**ORDER ON LATE FILING FOR CLAIMANTS DISCOVERED BY THE EXAMINER
AFTER THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF CLAIM FORMS**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on October 17, 2005 as a result of a status conference where all counsel were present to discuss the progress of the settlement of the case. During the hearing, the Examiner requested that the Court permit late filings for class-wide benefits for those individuals discovered by the Examiner that will need to have relatives disinterred and re-interred who may not have timely filed a claim form. After considering the matter, the Court hereby

ORDERS and ADJUDGES as follows:

1. The Examiner shall have until January 13, 2006 to notify class members who have not previously filed claim forms of the right to file a late claim form where the Examiner determines that the class member's relative needs to be disinterred.

2. The Court shall allow class members who fall within this limited category to file claim forms by no later than Friday, March 3, 2006.

3. The Examiner shall notify the class members of this deadline in writing on or before January 13, 2006.
